Setting Your Camp Promotion Goals





- Create a Calendar with campaigns and deadlines
- Set & reserve camp dates by November
- Promotional Packets to congregations in January
- Schedule a Camp Promotion Day in March or April
- Registration Materials available by February
 - Include Early Bird discount
 - Printed registration option
 - Online registration ready to go
- Create incentives such as Bring a Friend discount, Family discounts, Free camp shirt or gift.

Camp Promotional Packets for Congregations



Include:

- Posters for bulletin boards
- Postcards to hand out
- Testimonials
- Fundraising Ideas
- Bulletin inserts and/or Electronic Ads for camp
- Give the Gift of Camp Campaign



Testimonials



Sharing personal stories about the benefits of the camp experience has great impact. 80% of new campers come from a word of mouth referral!

- Regional/Conference promotional materials and in local churches.
 - A written piece
 - A video
 - A spoken piece
- Invite campers of all ages to share how camp influenced them
- Invite counselors or directors to share the benefits of camp



Posters & Postcards

Create a poster with your camp theme and graphic with dates for camps & early bird discount dates to be posted in churches

Utilize the same graphics/theme to **create a postcard** to be handed out during Regional/Conference wide events and in local congregations

Give postcards to campers & adults to give to their friends & colleagues.

Use postcards to give out to local youth organizations

Bulletin Inserts & Electronic Ads for camp



Using your Camp theme and graphic, create bulletin inserts or an ad to be placed on the video screen before church.

Advertise promotional deadlines & fundraisers.

Give the Gift of Camp Campaign



One of the biggest barriers for families of campers is the cost. Conferences & Regions also incur large expense by paying for counselors & staff to be at camp.


- Consider Conference/Region-wide fundraising campaigns to offset these costs through scholarships.
 - Family discounts for more than one child/adult going to camp from family
 - T-Shirt/hat sales
 - Each congregation underwrite the cost of one camp staff for a week
- Local churches can also make a commitment to scholarship youth & camp staff attending camp from their church.
